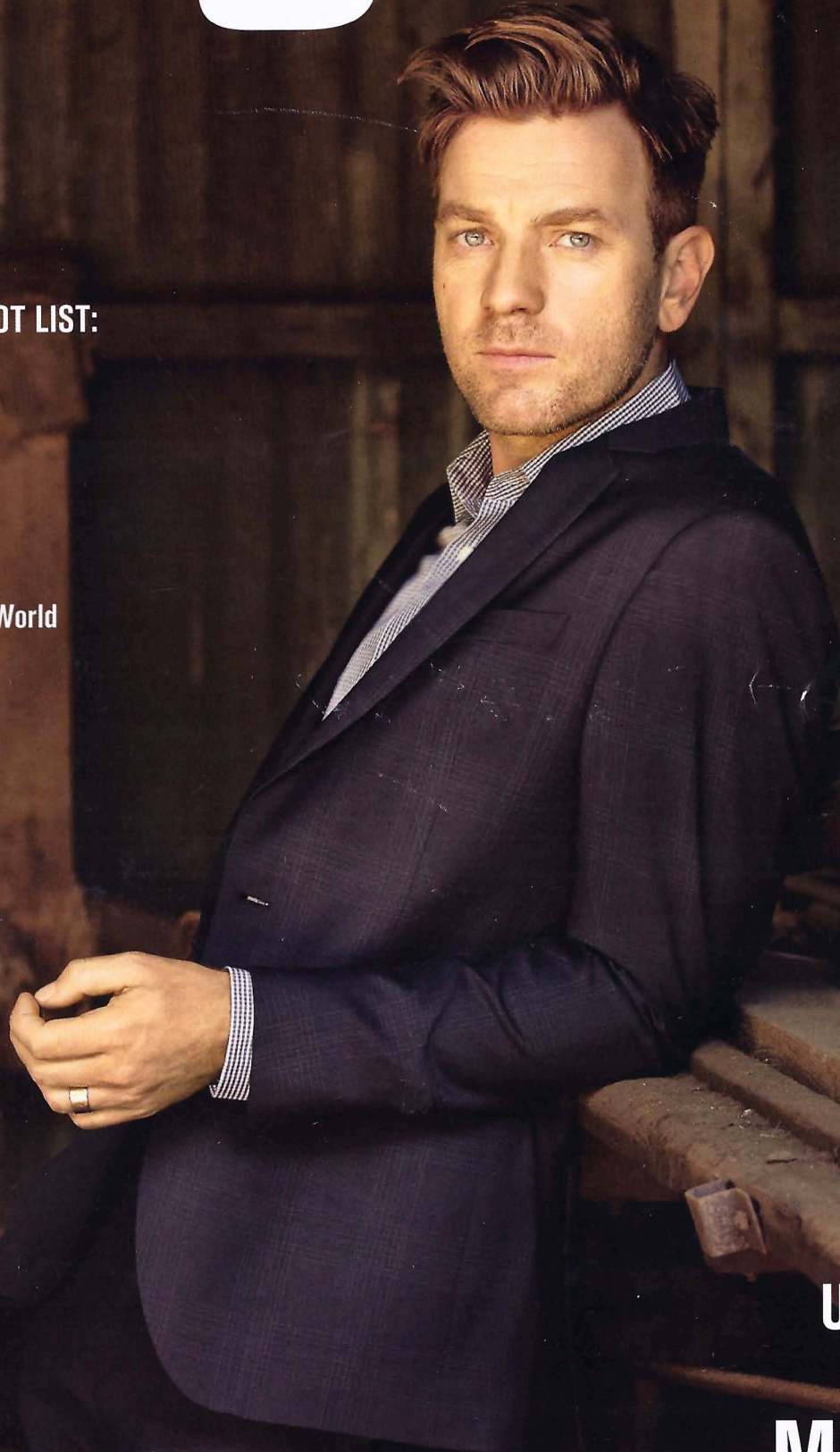

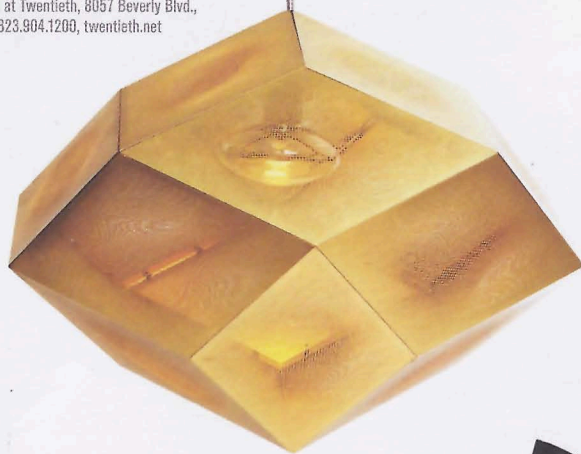

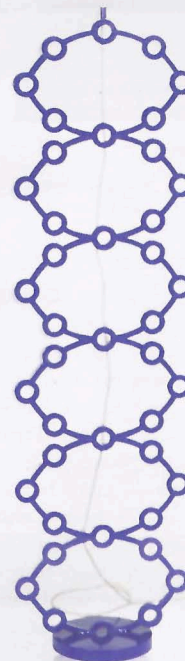


## Glow Moments

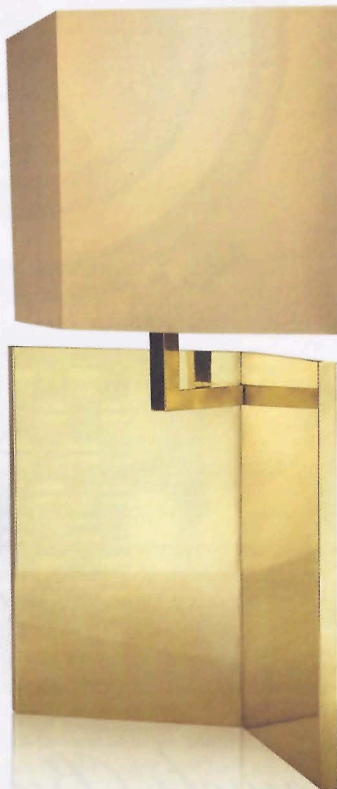
