Artist and glassblower Caleb Siemon realized his knack for glass at a young age, so after graduating from the Rhode Island School of Design, he ventured to the glass capital, Murano, Italy, and earned an apprenticeship with renowned Murano glass sculptor Pino Signoretto. Consequently, much of Siemon's work today is crafted with a heavy Italian influence.

+ TRUE COLORS

The "Lattimo" line, named after the Italian glass technique using opaque colors, is made by Siemon and a team of assistants at a studio in Southern California. The "Lattimo" line relies on the beauty of simplicity. "The subtlety of the Lattimo colors allows you to enjoy the elegant silhouettes of the shapes without being distracted," says Carmen Salazar, Siemon's wife and business partner.
